Further Mathematics

Students who are interested in Further Mathematics A-level should talk to the Head of Mathematics for details of the course. Further Mathematics is only available to pupils who have gained a very high grade in either GCSE Mathematics or IGCSE Mathematics.

Further Mathematics is a fully taught A-level and has the same lesson allocation as that for any other A-level.

A further six modules in Mathematics will be studied these include all three Further Pure Mathematics modules.

There are two combinations leading to an A-level in Further Mathematics these being:

Either: Modules

Further Pure 1, Mechanics 1, Mechanics 2 in the Lower Sixth
and

Further Pure 2, Further Pure 3, Mechanics 3 in the Upper Sixth

or: Modules

Further Pure 1, Mechanics 1, Mechanics 2 in the Lower Sixth
and

Further Pure 2, Further Pure 3, Statistics 2 in the Upper Sixth

Students may also be given the option to study Mechanics 4 in the Upper Sixth.

Each module is examined in the same way as for A-level Mathematics.

Strong candidates will have the opportunity to sit further examinations such as STEP (Sixth Term Entry Papers) when this is felt to be appropriate or required.
