Boarders consent for trips.

Parents will be aware that pupils are involved from time to time in various trips and visits. Sometimes these are organised well in advance, on occasions more spontaneously, perhaps depending on the weather.

We need to have parental agreement that they are willing for their child to take part in these activities. However, given the problems of communicating quickly, it is sometimes difficult to obtain permission in time. We therefore request that parents give their agreement to allow the head of the boarding house to sign on the parent's behalf for any activity arranged. In this way we will not have to contact parents every time a trip is organised. As well as school trips this permission may also cover staying with a host family or family of a school friend over the weekend, for instance.

This arrangement will *not* apply to activities arranged during the school holidays. As these are always arranged well in advance and may involve overnight stays we shall seek your permission separately.

If you are willing please sign section 7 on the Registration Form. Failure to consent will mean that parental permission will have to be sought on every separate occasion. Should a parent not be willing, or their consent arrives too late, it will mean that the child will not be able to take part in the activity.
